On view locally and at NAFF September 4-12, 2017

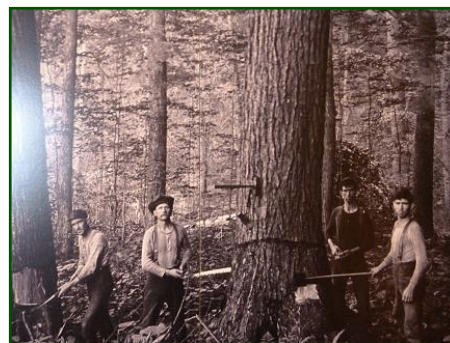
